- Records digital video content and performs post-production editing and produces motion graphics content.

- Coordinates and supervises other team members to capture video content for various projects.
- Work collaboratively to ensure an elevated look on an array of productions, including EPK interviews, on-set BTS coverage, in-the-field shoots, live events, and in-studio marketing productions including custom builds, green screen set-ups, and everything in between.
- Utilizes cinema-style production equipment (DSLR, cinema cameras, various camera support and movement equipment, lighting and light modifiers) to capture cinematic quality footage
- Manages and maintains digital assets and archives of video content so that assets are accessible for all users and available for utilization through various video projects
- Develop and foster best-practices and guidelines for the team.
- Operate run-and-gun efforts safely while maintaining outstanding quality consistently.
- Ensure that all equipment, batteries, lenses, lighting, recording media is pre-tested, and prepacked and ready to be wheels up within 15-30 minutes of the deployment teams call to respond to a disaster.
- Ensure recordable media reliability and security including providing backups.
- Help develop a lite, mobile field package with the team.
- In the editing suite follows the direction of the Field Producer to both archive and assemble storyline pieces.
